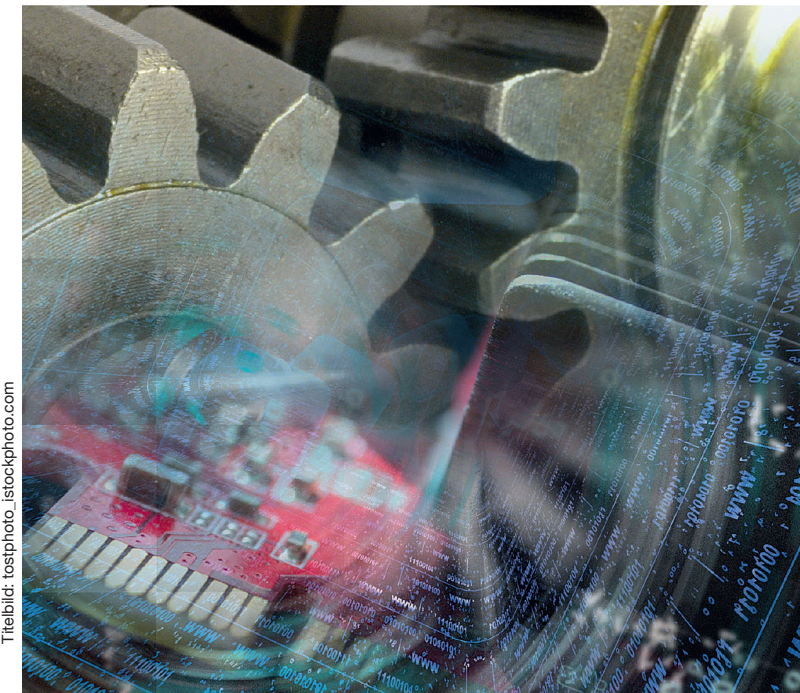

After 50 years, this is a good possibility to look back and be prepared for the challenges of the future.


